



## ATTENTION: SPECIAL PUBLIC DEFENDERS OR TRIAL ATTORNEYS SEEKING TO WITHDRAW

Your obligations to your client and to this court do not end with the filing of the notice of appeal. Compliance with Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.140(d)(1) is mandatory. This includes the following:

- (a) A statement of judicial acts to be reviewed has been filed.
- (b) Directions to the clerk have been filed, if necessary.
- (c) A designation to court reporter for necessary transcripts has been filed, correctly designating the days and judge before which proceedings were conducted and sent to the proper court reporter. Designations shall be filed within ten days of filing the notice of appeal and statement of judicial acts. See Rule 9.140(f)(2)(A).

Failure to comply timely with these provisions may result in sanctions from this court.
