



NOTICE TO APPELLANT CONCERNING THE RECORD

Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.200(e) provides that it is the appellant's burden to insure that the record on appeal is prepared and sent to this court.

PLEASE CHECK FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- Has the preparation fee been paid to the circuit court clerk? The circuit court clerk will not forward the record on appeal to this court until all of the fees are paid.
- Have all of the designated transcripts been included in the record?
- Is the record in correct and complete form for review by the appellate court?
- Has the trial court transmitted the record to the Fourth District Court of Appeal? **NOTE:** Your receipt of the index does not mean the record has been or will be transmitted to this court.
